Date	Your Request / Action	Defense/GMT Response	Legal Significance
Jan 2024	Requests for inventory resolution (e.g., golf cart, ride-ons) to cover hotel costs.	Ignored / Obstructive	Demonstrates Plaintiff's good faith attempt to mitigate damages caused by asset seizure.
Feb 2024	Repeated inquiries regarding living expenses and child needs.	Minimal / Non-Responsive	Shows Plaintiff's priority was child/living needs while facing destitution.
Mar 2024	Request for itemized lists for potential sale of non-personal assets.	Denied / Ignored	Proves Plaintiff was "squeezed" and prevented from liquidating non-essential assets.
May 2024	Communication regarding the transition of care and management of living expenses.	Continued non-compliance	Establishes the pattern of asymmetry where Plaintiff seeks cooperation and is met with silence.
